Jean-Paul FORCEVILLE, graduated from Paris Business School in 1979 and then from the Ivy League College for Post Office and Telecommunications service in 1986.

He joined La Poste in 1979 and was in charge with various functions in the fields of sales, communications, and he also worked for the Financial Division. From 1990 to 1992 he was Adviser for Finance and Planning to the Minister for Posts, Telecommunications and Space and continued with this office to the Minister for Public Service, State Reform and Decentralization from 1997 to 1998.

In 1992, he was appointed Director General of Sofipost, the holding company of La Poste subsidiaries. In 1995, he joined La Poste Strategic Division as Deputy Director and in 1998, he was Chief of Staff to the Chairman and CEO of La Poste Group.

In 2001, Jean-Paul Forceville became Director for External Relations and in addition, Director European and International Affairs, in 2004.

In May 2014, he was appointed Director, Regulatory Affairs and External Relations and in 2015, Director Regulatory, Institutional and European Affairs.

He is also a member of the supervisory board of La Banque Postale, board member of Asendia (co-enterprise between Swiss Post and La Poste) and chairman of the management board of Mediapost Vietnam (co-enterprise between Vietnam Post and La Poste).

Since 1st January 2011, he chairs the PostEurop Management Board, association which represents the interests of 53 European postal operators.
