1. PostEurop Philatelic Industry Forum in Krakow 2018: Innovative, Creative & Successful!

Over 100 participants representing 22 postal administrations, printers, manufacturers and other stakeholders within the philatelic trade joined us for our biennial PostEurop Stamp & Philately Forum in Krakow, co-organised by Poczta Polska S.A.



Two morning sessions were dedicated to conferences enabling representatives of postal administrations and philatelic market stakeholders to learn about the latest trends in the industry. The afternoon sessions were entirely dedicated to deepening business contacts or to creating new relationships. Participants had the possibility to plan meetings beforehand in an environment that facilitated the exchanges.

An open and informal atmosphere during individual meetings created occasion for discussions, exchanging ideas and business prospects for future common projects.

The outcome of a questionnaire about the Forum participants were asked to complete was overwhelmingly positive. Many encouraged the organizers to continue the Forums to come in the same way. Here are some of remarks I would like to share with you:
