

COVID-19 EU Briefing 01 June 2022

The new Weekly EU COVID-19 Briefing will include recent developments from the EU on treatments, vaccines and high-level announcements as well as important restrictions updates on a Member State level.

General EU Developments

International:

- **Germany:** As of 1 June, people entering Germany will no longer have to show proof of vaccination or negative test result or demonstrate a recent recovery from the coronavirus. The 3G rule on entry will be suspended until the end of August.
- **Italy:** Italy abolished all entry rules for international travellers as of 1 June.
- **Austria:** Austria's Green Pass rules will change in August, three vaccinations will be needed for people to be considered fully vaccinated in Austria.

Domestic:

- **The Netherlands:** Hospitals received 354 patients on 30 May, 21% lower than the week before when 447 people were hospitalised, figures from the national coordination centre for patient distribution (LCPS) show.
- **Italy:** A mask mandate is set to remain in force until at least 15 June.
- **Cyprus:** Starting on 1 June, citizens are excluded from the requirement to wear a protective mask in closed spaces except for hospitals, where visitors will continue wearing a mask in order to enter those.
- **Greece:** Until at least 15 September, citizens will be able to enter all indoor areas without a mask. Exceptions are healthcare facilities and nursing homes, as well as urban public transport (metro, electric railway, buses, trolleybuses and trams).
- **Portugal:** The country is currently the second in the world with the most cases per million inhabitants. Nevertheless, public authorities have recognised that the sixth wave peak has already passed. The “state of alert” will continue until 30 June, meaning until then that masks are required in transport and health facilities.
- **Slovenia:** On 30 May, the government lifted all remaining restrictions. There is currently no single restriction related to covid-19.
