EUROPA

EUROPA stamps are amongst the most collected and popular stamps in the world. They are specially issued by European postal administrations/enterprises under the aegis of PostEurop in which Europe is its central theme. EUROPA stamps represent cooperation amongst postal operators and promote philately. They exist to build awareness of the common roots, culture and history of Europe and its common goals.

Did you know that?

The world's oldest known wooden wheel was discovered in Slovenia! Dating back over 5,000 years? EUROPA stamps have been issued annually since 1956 and are a tangible symbol of Europe's desire for closer integration and cooperation. Since 1993, PostEurop is responsible for issuing EUROPA stamps. Over the years, EUROPA stamp has gained more interest within the Postal community as well as with philatelists and reflects the engagement from the members in diligently participating in the competition.

In order to promote EUROPA issues among philatelists, PostEurop created in 2002 an annual competition of the "Best EUROPA stamp" and since 2007; the winner is elected through an open and public voting procedure on the PostEurop website.

By January 2011, the EUROPA logo, preceded by a symbolic reminder of the mailbox, applies, and for the first time, a Jury Prize Competition is designed by seven philatelic experts to complement the online competition.
