

# Celebrating EUROPA Stamps 70th Anniversary - Young European Artists Postcard Design Competition 2026

Organized by the Stamps & Philately Working Group @PostEurop

## Introduction

In 2026, EUROPA stamps celebrate their 70th anniversary. First issued in 1956 by six countries – Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, and the Netherlands – the stamps symbolized peace, unity, and cooperation in Europe. Today, the EUROPA stamp family has grown to 53 postal organizations across the continent.

To mark this milestone, PostEurop invites **young European artists and design students** to participate in a **postcard design competition**. This is a unique chance for the next generation to showcase their creativity, contribute to philatelic history, and help celebrate the EUROPA legacy.

## Theme:

Participants are invited to create an original illustration or design that

Represents the concept of Unity in Europe.

## **Objectives**

- Inspire young artists to express their vision of **Unity in Europe**.
- Highlight the principle of European unity, which has always been and continues to be the
  driving force behind the EUROPA stamp initiative and an essential part of PostEurop's work.
- Encourage appreciation of philately, writing letters and postcards and sending traditional mail among younger generations.

# Who can participate

- Young people and design school students in age 18–25 years living in countries/ territories authorized to issue EUROPA stamps. List of countries and territories: https://europastamps.eu/about/authorised-companies
- One submission per participant.

# **Submission Requirements**

Participants must submit:

- A digital design file, specifications:
  - o **Format:** Portrait or landscape orientation
  - O Dimensions: 148 × 105 mm
  - o **File type:** High-resolution PDF, JPG, TIFF or EPS
  - o **Color mode:** CMYK
  - o Resolution: Minimum 300 dpi, maximum 2400 dpi
  - Bleed: 3 mm (optional, if design extends to the edge)
- A short description of the design concept (how it reflects unity in Europe) and creative process (max 50 words).



- Personal details
  - o Full name
  - o Age
  - o Country of residence
  - Instagram username (or similar online profile)
  - Website address (if available)

#### Use of Generative AI

Participants may use generative AI as part of their creative process. However, each submission must be accompanied by a short text explaining the underlying creative idea, the artistic intention, and the crafting process behind the work.

# **Jury Disclaimer**

The jury reserves the right to disqualify submissions that are purely Al-generated or that lack an original creative concept. This ensures that the winning entry reflects genuine artistic thought and not solely Al-produced imagery.

## **Judging & Voting**

- Designs will be showcased on the official EUROPA stamp website: https://europastamps.eu/
- An **expert jury** of internationally recognized designers will evaluate all entries.
- Three to five winners will be selected.

#### **Prizes**

- Each winning entry will receive financial award of €500.
- The winning designs will be:
  - o Produced as a printed framed artwork and diploma for the artist
  - o Produced as **postcard sets**, professionally printed on premium paper.
  - Each winner will receive 25 reference copies of postcard sets.
  - PostEurop members obtain usage rights for the winning design for producing postcards with the winning design during 2026-2027

# **Timeline**

- Launch of competition / Call for entries: 24 November 2025
- Deadline for submission: 14 April 2026
- Expert jury evaluation: 9 May 9 September 2026
- Winners announced and submission exhibited: October 2026, at the PostEurop General Assembly (date TBC)
